I am looking forward to helping you achieve excellence as you continue to explore the basic building blocks of algebra and geometry introduced in Math 1. Topics we will focus on include quadratics, transformations, congruence, similarity, and right triangle trigonometry. You are encouraged to come to class every day, study regularly, complete all assignments with diligence, and always ask for help when you need it. If you do these things, I am confident you will be successful in this class. Please know I will do everything I can to help you reach your goals. CLASS POLICIES:

• **ATTENDANCE**

To achieve success in math, it is important for you to attend class regularly. Each day's class work builds on prior learning. If a student misses just one day, they have difficulty following new assignments. You have **ONE WEEK** to make up tests for full credit. When you are absent please check the website calendar for all notes and assignments. Failure to make up work will result in a grade deduction for that assignment. An absence of one class period will not excuse a student from turning in previously assigned work on the day they return to class.

• **GRADING**

Students will take the NC Final Exam (NCFE) in Math 2 at the completion of the course.

• **HOMEWORK**

Homework will be checked daily for completion. You will receive credit if ALL problems are written; numbered, attempted, and all necessary work is shown. You will receive partial credit for partially completed homework. If you do not have your homework, no points are awarded. If you are absent, it is your responsibility to show me the assignment the day that you return. Each unit you will be given a homework calendar and homework packet for that unit. Homework will be checked daily for completion. You will earn full credit if ALL problems are clearly attempted and all necessary work is shown. If you do not have your homework, you can bring it the next day for half credit. *If you are absent, it is your responsibility to show me the assignment when you are well, as well as getting the homework you missed.*

• **QUIZZES**

Quizzes are to be expected every week and may or may not be announced. If you are absent on the day of a quiz, you will need to make it up upon return as per RHS policy. No quizzes can be made up after the completion of the unit. It is YOUR responsibility to schedule a time to make up your quiz after school, before school or during lunch. Quizzes may not be made up during class time.

The 50 Club: If you make above a 50 on your quiz and show mastery by scoring higher on your test, your quiz grade will be replaced by your test grade. If you make below a 50 on your quiz and pass your test your quiz grade will be replaced by a 60.

• **TESTS**

Tests will always be announced. If you are absent the day before a test, you must still take the test with your class. If you are absent the day of a test, you have **ONE WEEK** to make up the test without deduction. It is YOUR

responsibility to schedule a time to make up your test. If you wait until the quarter deadlines to make up a test, then you will have a deduction up to 30 points taken off of your test grade. There are NO EXCEPTIONS to this rule.

- **TEST CORRECTIONS/ POINTS BACK**

Every student has the potential to excel in this class. After a unit test, all students will be given a dedicated period of time to complete test corrections. A later date will be determined for you to complete a shorter *Gimme Back My Points* (GBMP) assessment during lunch. You will earn credit back for each correct answer on the GBMP. If your initial test score is below 50 but you demonstrate mastery on the GBMP, your test score will be recovered to 60.

- **CLASSWORK**

As part of your classwork grade you will have notebook checks throughout the quarter. You are required to keep a notebook in page order designated by the teacher. These notebooks will be checked for order and accuracy.

- **TUTORING**

If students need extra help, I will be available on Tuesdays from 2:30-3:30. Please make sure that you have reliable means of transportation if you are staying after school. ***I need to know in advance if you are riding the Activity Bus home.***

- **TEACHER WEBSITE**

BYOD EXPECTATIONS

First violation: Verbal warning.
